“The nose is fruity and offers a small intensity. It reveals notes of juicy/pulpy cassis, wild strawberry, small notes of blueberry associated with fine touches of violet, crushed blueberry as well as fine hints of nutmeg. The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers a good definition, gourmandize, juiciness as well as a small concentration. On the palate the wine expresses notes of juicy cassis, blackberry, small notes of raspberry associated with small touches of blueberry as well as hints of violet, nutmeg and tobacco. Good length.”

Rating : 92/100- 16/20- LeVertdevin PRIMEUR – June 2020

The bouquet of 2019 initially displays an inviting floral character revealing nuances of lime blossom and chamomile. Also appear notes of blackberries and graphite followed by a fine touch of aging through chocolate. Fresh and slightly creamy character on the palate. The wine has ample but tight tannins that are in tune with the freshness of the acid structure. The wine has tone and a beautiful aromatic intensity, from the attack to the finish. It is certainly one of the best Fougas that I have ever tasted... with the 2016. These two are leading the marathon head to head...
